World Alzheimers Month



World Alzheimer's Month is the international campaign by <u>Alzheimer's Disease</u> <u>International</u> (ADI) every September to raise awareness and challenge the stigma that surrounds dementia. World Alzheimer's Month was launched in 2012.

World Alzheimer's Day is on September 21st each year. World Alzheimer's Day was launched in 1994 to mark the 10th anniversary of Alzheimer's Disease

International (ADI) and has grown significantly since then. In 2019 we know of 94 countries that undertook activity during the month and especially around World Alzheimer's Day. The world lights up purple on World Alzheimer's day, a day dedicated to raising awareness about Alzheimer's and dementia.

Every three seconds someone in the world develops dementia/Alzheimer's, according to Alzheimer's Disease International (ADI). So because of this, organizations around the world come together on this day to support finding a cure for this sorrowful disease.

office to update your email. You will then be able to renew through the link sent to you from NCCAP via email.

NCCAP is now following an audit process for continuing education.

You will not need to upload your certificates of proof of continuing education clock hours to your online profile on the NCCAP website or mail to the office. If you are chosen for an audit, you will be sent an email within days of your renewal submission and at that time you will be instructed on how to send in your certificates.

When your application for re-certification has been reviewed and approved you will receive your NCCAP certificate as a PDF via email. Contact the office if you wish to have a hard copy of your certificate for a nominal fee at info@nccap.org
